

Haltom Area Band Friends (HABF) is a 501(C)(3) Tax Exempt Organization. All donations are tax deductible. HABF consists of anyone associated with the combination bands of: Haltom High School, Haltom Middle School, North Oaks Middle School and Watauga Middle School.

The purpose of HABF is to:

Promote parental understanding of the students' activities, opportunities and objectives in the band program.

Secure closer contact between parents, students and band directors.

Foster closer ties between parents of younger students and parents of high school students.

Promote music culture in the community by fostering concert attendance and public support of band activities, thereby rendering moral support to the students.

Render financial aid in areas necessary for realizing the objectives of the Haltom Area Bands.

The HABF Board is elected at the Spring Concert each year. The Band Board positions and responsibilities are:

President: oversee all positions and committees

1st Vice President: will be the next year's president; organize bus sponsors, haulers and uniform maintenance

2nd Vice President (Fundraising): organize all fundraising events

3rd Vice President (Volunteer Chairman): secure volunteers for various events and projects; keep track of volunteer hours for HABF

4th Vice President (Hospitality): responsible for meals to students; organize meals and refreshments for HABF as needed

Secretary: take minutes at board and general meetings

Treasurer: Receive all money that is paid to HABF and pays all bills and taxes for the organization

Parliamentarian: make sure meetings follow proper procedure

Historian: create annual concert program
