

Marching Festival Volunteer FAQ

1. Where do I go when I get to the FAAC?

Check in at the Volunteer check-in table (at the entrance into the FAAC), so we know that you're at the festival and your position is filled.

- a. For each shift that you're scheduled, you will be given a meal ticket. The meal ticket is good for a free sandwich/drink at the concession stand.
- b. You will be given an Orange or Red wrist band (this signifies that you're a volunteer).
- c. There will be free water for the Volunteers at the check-in table.

2. What do I wear?

Most positions require that you stand, so please wear comfortable shoes and your Haltom spirit wear.

3. What should I do if the shift worker scheduled after me doesn't show up?

Please go and tell the people at the Volunteer check-in table that you are leaving your position and there is no one replacing you. The person at the Volunteer check-in table will send a floater to your position.

4. How do I reach Haltom personnel at the marching festival? We will leave multiple cell numbers at the Volunteer check-in table, so are you able to reach some one, if necessary.
