

Texas Motor Speedway (TMS) FAQ

- 1. What do we do?** As ushers we are responsible for: ensuring the aisles remain clear: assisting people to find their seats; helping folks who think they are in the right section, but really aren't, to find the right section.
- 2. What DON'T we do?** We don't get involved in ANY conflict or dispute. If you can't get someone to understand they are in the wrong section, get a supervisor. They are everywhere and they are the ones who handle those things. Basically, we are the "good guys". Smile, help people who need to know where to go, and enjoy the race.
- 3. How long will I be there?** It depends. Different races have different needs for staffing. Typically, the shift is between 4 and 7 hours.
- 4. What's the traffic like?** Again, it depends. Usually, going into the speedway most people are already there. The folks who come the day of the race are going to be coming AFTER you arrive. On the way out: on Saturday most people are staying at the track (camping, RV, etc.); on Sunday the traffic has been both bad and extremely light. We have only been there about 4 times and Sunday departure traffic has been different each time.
